The month of AUGUST was renamed in honor of the 1st Roman Emperor, Augustus, a statesman and military leader. August was also lengthened from 30 to 31 day to equal Juluis Caesar’s month of July. The flower is the Gladiolus and the birthstones Peridot and Sardonyx. It is also national goat cheese month. There are more vacations and holidays taken in August than any other month. The Zodiac signs are Leo (7/23 - 8/22) and Virgo (8/23 - 9/22).

The month of SEPTEMBER comes from the Latin "*sep tem*," meaning seven, since it was the seventh month on the Roman calendar. September marks the beginning of the Autumn Equinox on the 22nd, which is the traditional transition from summer into fall. More people are born in September than any other month. The flower is the Morning Glory, and the birthstone Sapphire. The Zodiac signs are Virgo (8/23 - 9/22) and Libra (9/23 - 10/23)
